

<b>Historical Astronomy Division (HAD)</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Events organized by the HAD and are of a similar type to the main AAS events, but on the topic of history in astronomy.</li> </ul>
<b>Special Sessions</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Suggested and organized by participants.</li> <li>Often run in parallel to oral sessions but with a structure of the organizer's design (as opposed to the standard oral session).</li> <li>Speakers are often invited, and there may be panels etc.</li> <li>These often deal with "state of the profession".</li> </ul>
<b>Press Conferences</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Arranged in advance for teams to present breaking news to press, etc.</li> <li>Anyone can attend press conferences and they often provide exciting, specific, science results presented in non-specialist terms.</li> </ul>
<b>Splinter</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Similar to special sessions these have usually be organized by attendees.</li> <li>Will be run with a structure designed by whoever is organizing but can last as long as needed (sometimes all day!)</li> <li>More common for observatories/missions.</li> </ul>
<b>Workshops</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The weekend preceeding the conference.</li> <li>These often are at cost and are topic specific.</li> <li>Run by interest groups in all areas.</li> </ul>
<b>Oral Sessions</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Parallel sessions of speakers arranged by topic.</li> <li>The majority of talks are 5 minutes long (unless they are dissertation talks).</li> </ul>
<b>Attendee Event</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Events organized by AAS.</li> <li>These are events for all attendees.</li> <li>They often have free food/drink and come with networking opportunities.</li> </ul>
<b>Town Hall</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Often given by government bodies (i.e., NASA, NSF) or large missions (i.e., The Nancy Grace Roman Telescope).</li> <li>Can be held in the day or during the evening (where there is sometimes free food and drink).</li> </ul>
<b>Exhibit Theater</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>A stage within the exhibit hall where exhibitors present short talks/workshops.</li> </ul>
<b>iPosters</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>All in the exhibit hall.</li> <li>These are organized by session number.</li> <li>In the morning these sessions come with free coffee, in the evening snacks and drinks.</li> </ul>
<b>Plenary</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>May also be described as a keynote.</li> <li>Geared towards a general astronomy audience.</li> <li>Nothing else will be scheduled during these times.</li> </ul>
